This is your opportunity to determine whether he really is the right person to do the job. Why would you trust someone if you're not sure that he could satisfy your expectations anyway?

For how long is the warranty?

Always think about the duration of warranty period that he is giving you. The longer it is, the more reliable his services are. Although it is unlikely, however whenever troubles come up, at least you got a calm state of mind that back jobs won't have charge.

Can you inform me what really is the problem with my car and what will you do about this if it was your own?

Asking what really is the issue with the car's system and which are the things that needs repairing gives you a clearer vision on what is he going to do with your vehicle and what are the parts that may need to have replacing in the process. Some mechanics would exaggerate charges and might advise you to change parts that are not necessarily in need of changing in the efforts of trying to extract your cash. Do not get quickly deceived. Ask him if as though the car was his own and what will he do about it. He will then start answering you straightforwardly and you are most likely to arrive at the fairest price of his efforts.

Can you show me information on what was done to my vehicle?
